President's Letter - January Meeting **High Speed Internet Access over Power Lines - BPL**

Duke Power will be conducting a trial of broadband powerline (BPL) in 2004. This technology will allow Duke Power to provide broadband internet access to customers by injecting an RF signal onto the power-

line. ARRL and others have raised concerns over the possibility that this technology will cause interference with HF and lower VHF radio.

David Masters, from Duke Power's BPL project team, will be joining us at the next club meeting, January 27, to discuss Duke's plans.

David is a veteran of the Air Force and has been with Duke Energy for 22 years. He has held a variety of positions in telecommunications at Duke Energy, most recently serving as Operations Director for Duke's telecom subsidiary, Duke-Net Communications.

This is a subject we should all be interested in learning more about as it has been a topic of much discussion among Hams. Please come with lots of questions for our guest.
