Bryan Ferdinand, K4NET made a presentation on Echolink. Echolink is ROIP (Radio Over Internet Protocol). Echolink allows licensed operators to communicate with each other worldwide. Licensed amateurs can use a PC, Mac or smartphone to access Echolink. Mac users access Echolink through Echomac. There are currently a total of 200,000 Echolink users worldwide. Echolink requires a computer interface, soundcard, mic and speakers. Rigblaster and Tigertronics Signalink USB are two pieces of affordable equipment needed to access Echolink via PC.
