In case you need additional admission tickets, prize tickets or parking tickets they will be available at the meeting.


Last month's auction of electronic gear seemed to go well. There were about 25 items auctioned. Some of the more interesting items that were auctioned off were a 40 meter antenna and a uhf amplifier. Many thanks to our Vice President, Wilton - WB4PCS who acted as auctioneer.

EchoLink, the Ham Internet Chat, is now approaching 250.000 members. It is not unusual to see 3,000-4,000 hams on at one time. There are four categories. You can hook up your repeater for wide area coverage. A -R is added to a callsign to indicate a repeater. You can set up a link -L so that you can use a hand held and a vhf or uhf rig to connect to echolink from various parts of your home or the backyard. You can set up to use a computer only (no letter). The final category is the Conference link that allows many to join together for large meetings or conferences.

A new addition is a program called EchoAnswer. When using a computer as your entry tool, you can set this up like a telephone answering machine. Should you have EchoLink up but are away from your computer, EchoAnswer will play a voice message you previously recorded to a visitor. Should the visiting ham leave you a message, another message can be sent thanking him for leaving a message. This is a free program and will save up to five incoming messages.

MARS Board Meeting February 1, 2005

Called to order at 7:00PM.

President's Report: The W4CQ club will hold a **Technician Class** at the Salvation Army beginning on Sat. Feb. 12 at 9:00AM. The class will run for three weeks. The CLTNE packet node may be experiencing problems. Shawn will check with Steve McCabe, KE4LVX.

Vice President: The Feb. club meeting will be the Hamfest meeting to explain the activities and request volunteers. The April meeting will be a RTTY demo by Ben Antanaitis, WB2RHM. We are also trying to line up Gary Pearce, KN4AQ, to talk about the status of BPL in NC and around the country.

Secretary: Updates to the reflectors have been done and the administrator's list has been updated (by Shawn). The secretary will locate the copy of last year's Pre-Reg database and send to Greg.

Treasurer: The Trailer storage bill has been paid, a copy of QuickBooks has been purchased for the club, the phone bill has been paid for the repeaters and auction expenses have been paid.

Committee Reports:

Shawn appointed a Membership Services chair, Jodie Rowland, KI4CXO.

Public Service: Three events are planned for 2005.

April 2 **MS Walk** Freedom Park

June 3-5 MS Challenge Walk

Sept. 24-25 **MS-150 Breakaway top the Beach**. This event will go through Darlington this year, no more Route 76 out of Florence!!

Hamfest: Shawn will plan a meeting the second full week of February and will send an e-mail notice.

Christmas Party: Due to the overwhelming positive feedback for the Pine Lake site, Dave Stewart will make arrangements for Dec. 3, 2005 at the same site. He reports meals may go up by \$1.

Field Day: Ben, WB2RHM, will chair this year's effort. The club is on the lookout for three used laptops, preferably with Minimum 300 MHz processors, 5-10 GB disks, large screens, USB ports, and a Minimum of 64 MB memory that will run Windows 98 SE 2nd Ed. These will be WiFi linked at the Field Day site. A motion by Wilton, WB4PCS and seconded by Bill, W4WNT, was unanimously approved to purchase up to 3 802.11b WiFi adapters plus one 802.11b Wireless router (which as specified by the 802.11b Standard must operate at 2.4 GHz) so we can network our W4BFB stations at FD, or whenever we wish, using a wireless LAN. We are also on the lookout for a tent to replace the SSB tent.

Old Business:

Ideas from the Jan. Board meeting are being followed. Shawn has made a contact with the Home School group. W4WNT will send the Member Packet files to Ben, WB2RHM for use a new members information packet. W4WNT will generate a file from the ARRL Members page of new and upgraded hams in the local area.

Festival in the Park used to have ham station set up as a demo. We could do a demo focusing on the Hurricane, Tornado, and Tsunami communications and locally on the ice storm response.

Wilton pointed out that in many conversations with non-hams, the question comes up about who provides the equipment, who pays for the hams' time, who feeds the volunteers, etc. People find it hard to believe that hams are doing all this effort for free. This would be a good point to emphasize in any publicity along with the public service nature of Amateur Radio and the basis in the FCC regs.

Meeting adjourned at 8:15 PM.
