- 2- Minutes for the board meeting of August 3rd, 2010 accepted as presented in the August newsletter.
- 3- Treasurer's Report: Tom presented the accounts report. This was accepted by the Board.
- 4- Vice Presidents report: Bill Fisher—W4GRW. September's meeting will be a talk on the Enigma Cypher Machine by Dave Wentzel-KD4ITI and a talk on the Boy Scout Jamboree by Paul Trotter-AA4ZZ
- 5- Secretary's report: Two new members were added to the roles this month and a recount shows we are at 146 current members.

Committee Reports:

Nomination Committee: This will be headed up by Bill Harding-K4AHK and Barry May-KC4SSS. We encourage all eligible members to run for the Board of Directors.

Repeater Committee: W4BFB BBS upgrade still in process. 146.535 Skywarn repeater is up and running.

<u>Public Service Committee</u>: The MS Bike Ride on Sept. 25th-26th will be our next major public service event. The new route has been decided with starts Pageland, Camden and Monroe. Sign Up will be handled at "Ride-Maps.com". Wilmington ARS has contacted Mary to assist with the amateur radio logistics. The SC Hearts Communications Trailer will be used for net control throughout the ride. Mary reported that she had been contacted by the organizers for the American Endurance Ride, to be held from October 14th thru the 16th. This is an Equestrian event being held at the Cooper Black Recreational area in Cheraw SC.
